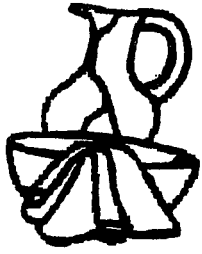

We have received a donation to the Debt Reduction Fund from Chris Terhune in memory of Mat Whitefleet.

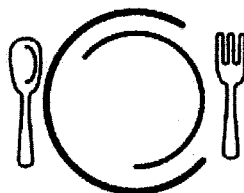

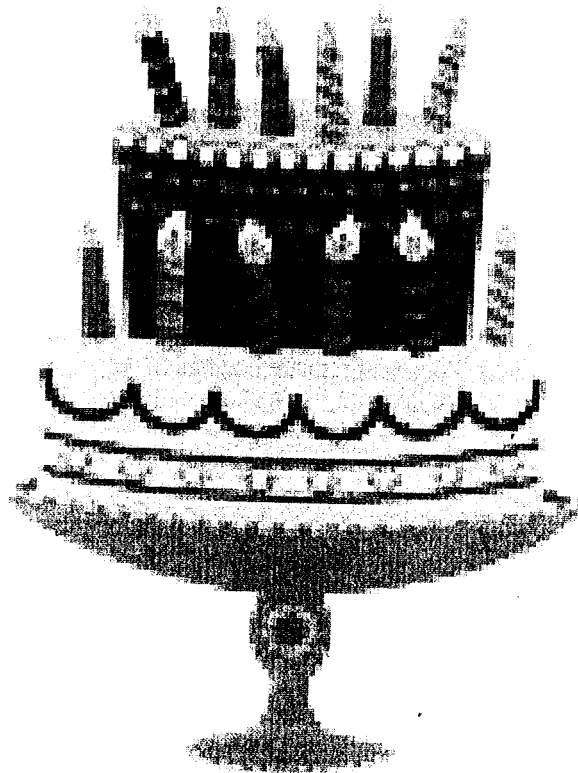
